A Morning to Remember – November 16, 2007 The ONE Mark McEwan

A Cross Cultural Dialogue on Learning Disabilities: Integra Partners with the Iranian Canadian Community

Integra has embarked on a collaborative project with the Iranian Canadian Social Service Providers Network (ICSSPN) to create a cross cultural dialogue on Learning Disabilities (LDs).

By sharing knowledge from both sides, we are seeking to deepen our understanding of what LDs look like in the context of Iranian-Canadian culture, and to share knowledge about LDs so that agency workers and parents in the Iranian Canadian community can become better equipped for dealing with issues surrounding LDs. A long-term goal of the project is to strengthen our services by developing culturally sensitive programs for children with LDs.

The project began with discussions about service needs and the various culturally-bound social issues. ICSSPN members Afie Mardouki, Parvin Samadzaden and Mandana Attarzadeh played key roles in shaping and co-ordinating the

project. Thus far, Integra staff Mohammad Dehgan-Pour and Melissa Rowbotham have presented four workshops addressing the social, emotional and behavioural aspects of LDs and how to access services.

Resources for all agency staff were provided, including a training manual on LDs in English and Farsi, a DVD training video, and access to case consultations from Integra staff and the Resource Centre at Integra.

Working on this collaboration has shed light on the complexity of mental health issues in the context of culture; we're learning how cultural values and meanings impact perceptions of mental health, and how to set practical goals in developing mutual



understanding. Integra would like to thank the ICSSPN and the workshop participants for their involvement.

We look forward to more collaborations in the future.

Michael Cole put it nicely in his book on cultural psychology: "Like fish in water, we fail to 'see' culture because it is the medium within which we exist."

David Jurasek came to Integra in September and quickly became immersed in the Mindfulness Martial Arts program, a boon to its creator, Paul Badali, who has seen his fledging program grow exponentially. As a skilled therapist, he brings a new slant - therapy through art.

Sarah Glover, who started her relationship with Integra as a counsellor, then supervisor at Camp Towhee, is now a Child & Family Therapist.

Our new Clinical Supervisor, Nelson Parker, has a comprehensive history of working with children and an intellectual, yet down to earth, approach to therapy.

Also back with us is Tanya Galway who is completing research toward a PhD.

And congratulations are in order. Lesley Daniels, who works in the Psychology and Research Department, has completed her clinical exams—the finale of years of study culminating in her PhD in Clinical Psychology.
