CAMP TOWHEE - SUMMER 2010!

Camp Towhee is a **therapeutic residential** summer program, operated by the Integra Foundation, a Children's Mental Health Centre in Toronto. Located on a private lake in the beautiful Haliburton Highlands, Camp Towhee offers two 3-week camp sessions for children and adolescents with *learning disabilities* and related social, emotional and behavioural problems.

Camp Towhee staff are college/university students and practitioners, with at least **2 years** of post-secondary school or related experience, in a variety of fields including social services, child and youth care, education and health. Camp Towhee offers training and supervision in the areas of learning disabilities, behaviour management, group facilitation, non-violent crisis intervention, and many others. Staff participate in an intensive training program prior to the campers' arrival, as well as between the two camp sessions, and receive supervision and feedback throughout the program. Accommodations and meals are provided free of charge, in addition to an *excellent salary, and ample time off.*

All employment contracts at Camp Towhee are from *June 20th to August 24th, 2010*

POSITIONS	DESCRIPTIONS
Cabin Counsellors	Member of a team of three that supports the group development and peer socialization of a group of 5-7 campers. Assists campers in managing daily routines and activities, and encourages their participation. Ensures and maintains camper safety at all times.
Counsellor Supervisors	Responsible for the support, supervision and evaluation of six cabin counsellors, and the support and supervision of 12 campers. Assists cabin counsellors in managing difficult camper behaviours. Works one on one with campers as required.
Program Leaders	In conjunction with program supervisors is responsible for designing, facilitating and reporting progress of the therapeutic and skill development focused programs for campers. Program areas include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adventure Based Learning (Ropes Course, Climbing Walls, etc.)• Experiential Arts (Drama, Music, Crafts, etc.)• Outtripping and Outdoor Skills• Waterfront (aquatics)
Program Supervisors	Responsible for program design, development and implementation, and for supervising, supporting and evaluating all program leaders in their designated program areas. (See above)
Support Staff	Provides general maintenance support duties for the camp.
Registered Nurse	The registered nurse works with and oversees the student nurse to provide health care to campers and staff. The nurse is responsible for preventing and treatment of illness and injuries and administering medications, as well as health teaching and health promotion activities.
Student Nurse	The student nurse works in conjunction with the registered nurse to provide health care to campers and staff. This position offers the individual the opportunity to work as a member of a multi-disciplinary team and develop knowledge and experience in many health-related areas.

Hiring for Camp Towhee is ongoing throughout the winter/spring until all jobs are filled. The earlier you submit your resume, the better the chance of getting the job you want. *We recommend that you submit your resume by January 31st, 2010. However, we will also receive and consider resumes submitted after this date.*
